

Sapporo International Art Festival 2024 Announces Six Venues

Three locations including Higashi 1-Chome Theater (Formerly Hokkaido Shiki Theater) to be used as venues for the first time

Sapporo International Art Festival (SIAF) is a triennial art event held in Sapporo, Japan, that showcases the latest contemporary forms of artistic expression from around the world.

We are delighted to announce the venues for SIAF2024, to be held from January 20 to February 25.

With six locations including the three first-time venues, Higashi 1-chome Theater, Sapporo Snow Festival Odori 2-chome Site, and Sapporo Cultural Arts Community Center (SCARTS), SIAF2024 will bring joy to Sapporo's winter. The outline of the exhibitions is planned to be announced early next year and will include information on some of the participating artists and their work.
